

BANQUET/PROM PROPOSAL

Everybody pays to attend the banquet/prom. The current amount will be \$15.00 each, but may need to be raised in the future to keep up with rising food costs.

The only free meals offered will be to the members of the school board and spouses and junior sponsors.

For the school year 1996-97 (the transitional year), the Student Council will pay for those Seniors who paid or sold sufficient amounts of Tom Wat last year. Those Seniors who did not pay or participate in the fund raiser as Juniors will be required to pay to attend the banquet/prom.

The payment method that will strictly be adhered to:

All individuals who are eligible and required to pay to attend the prom must have their full payment in before school is dismissed for Christmas vacation.

All student dates and teacher/coach/administrator spouses who plan to attend must have the total amount paid before school is dismissed for Spring Break.

If payment is not made according to the above schedules, that individual may not attend. (The only exceptions that will be made are for students moving into the district.)

The previous policy of inviting staff members will remain in effect—only teachers that serve on the rotation of sponsorships and teach/coach high school students at least one hour qualify.

Senior expenses will be handled during the Senior year. There should be sufficient carryover money for graduation expenses (\$100-200). If not, there may have to be a fund raiser or a fee charged each graduating senior.

If Seniors wish to have colored pictures in the annual, that will be addressed during the Senior year. It is an optional fringe benefit, and they may choose to pay for the color or come up with a way of raising the funds.
