

TARDY POLICY

The following procedures will be followed when dealing with tardies:

- 3rd Unexcused Tardy: One day detention; parents will be notified.
- 4th Unexcused Tardy: Two days detention; parents will be notified.
- 5th unexcused Tardy: Three days detention; parents will be notified.
- 6th unexcused Tardy: One day Saturday school; parents will be notified.
- 7th unexcused Tardy: Students will serve one day suspension; parents will be notified.
- 8th unexcused Tardy: Students will be suspended for three days; parents will be notified.

If a student must leave the room for any reason other than medical or emergencies, he or she will be considered tardy unless prior permission from the teacher.

All tardies will start over at the beginning of each (9) nine weeks.
