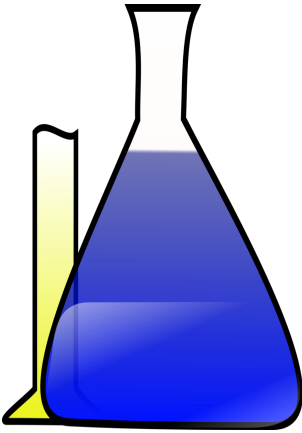

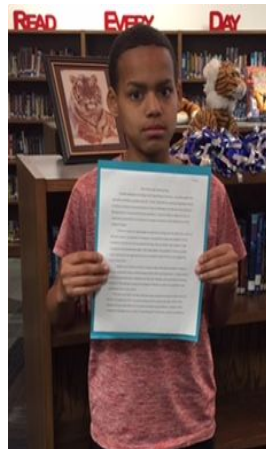

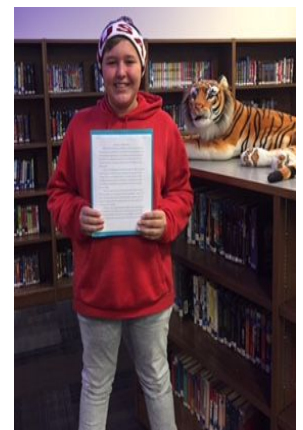


Commerce Students Excel in Writing Contest

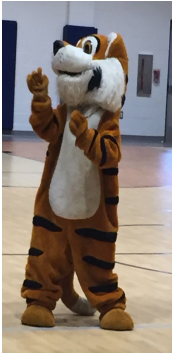
CONGRATULATIONS!
