

Blake is in the back chewin' his gum, Man, he sure looks like he's havin' fun!


Damyon and Klint are puttin' on game faces, While Amanda and Katie are tightenin' their laces

Our poem is over, we have to go cheer, Little did we know, it was the last game of the year!


