The Tigers then went on to defeat Foyil to become district champions. With the win

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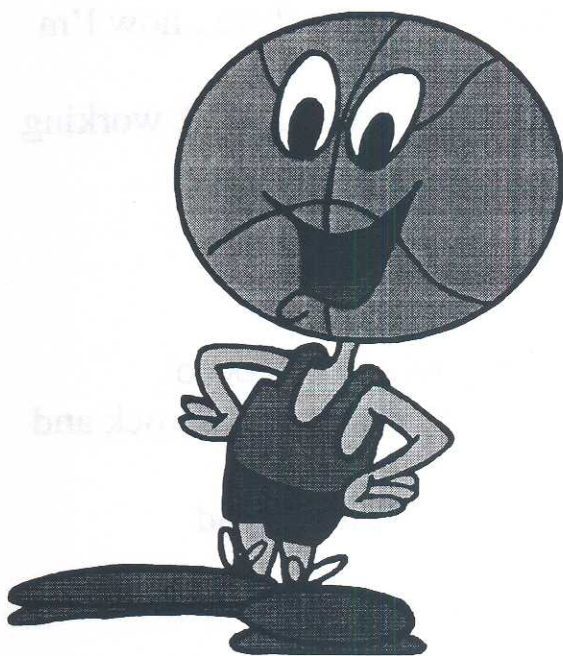
regional play.

# Weightlifting

Power lifting season is here now, with the first meet already behind us. This year, the area football coaches decided to spark a return of the Lucky 7 Weight Meet. We took 9 lifters: James Sullivan, Tim Osborn, Derek Spriggs, Trent Kisse, Jarod Thronebury, Jared Dopp, Trent Craghead, Chad Trease, and Perry Ketron. The team went into the meet with very little experience in meets, but showed that no matter what, those that work the hardest will always triumph.

Craghead, because of knee surgery in football season, could only bench press, but won that event in his weight class. Tim won the 168 lb. class because of a tie, as he was the lighter lifter. James won the 198 lb. class, with Thronebury and Spriggs behind him, respectively. Dopp took the 220 lb. class with ease, with the meet-high dead lift of 550 lbs. I(Perry) took the 275 lb. class with a meet high squat of 465 lbs. and bench-press of 295 lbs. Commerce also took the all around meet win.

There will be a Regional Weight Meet held on March 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> at Hilldale High School in Muskogee. We would like to congratulate all of the lifters for showing good sportsmanship and competition at the meet and also wish them good luck at the upcoming Regional Competition. The top 5 qualifiers in each weight class will qualify for the State Meet, at which the top five lifters from each class will be honored.

For those who don't know the rules, I thought I could help out and give some of the basics:

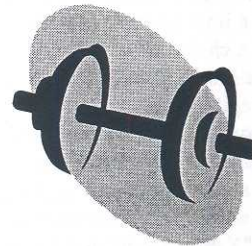
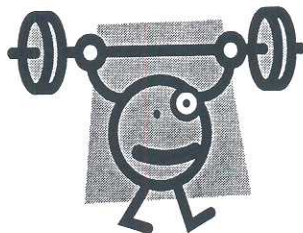
1. Lifters are divided into classes by weight

2. The top lifters will be named from the result of a 3 lift total of the Squat, Bench Press, and Dead Lift

3. Each lifter is given 3 attempts in each of the different lifts to maintain their highest lift, which is used for the final tally of points

4. Each lift must be done by the rules set at that meet

5. There are two separate meets for Big Schools-3A through 6A, and Small Schools-C through 2A

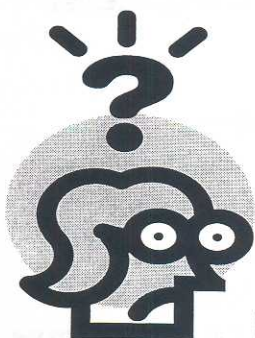
