Breast Cancer Facts

- One in eight women or 12.6% of all woman will get breast cancer in her lifetime.
- Every 13 minutes a woman dies of breast cancer.
- of women with breast cancer are over 50.
- The first sign of breast cancer usually shows up on a woman's mammogram before it can be felt or any other symptoms are present.
- Early detection of breast cancer, through monthly breast self-exams and particularly yearly mammography after age 40, offers the best chance for survival.
- Ninety-six percent of women who find and treat breast cancer early will be cancer-free after five years.
- Over eighty percent of breast lumps are not cancerous, but benign such as fibrocystic breast disease.
- Breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer death in woman between the ages of 15 and 54, and the second cause of cancer death in women 55 to 74.

- Most recommend breast selfexaminations once a month the week following your menstrual period if you are age 20 or older.
- Experts in the field of diet and cancer agree that changes in diet and lifestyle may reduce the incidence of cancer generally.

Lady Tiger Softball: District Champs, Regional Champs, and ... STATE QUARTERFINALISTS


