

On March 13, CHS's Science and History Clubs took a field trip to OKC. They toured the Oklahoma Bombing Memorial and then ventured over to the Myriad Botanical Gardens. Their final stop was the Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation where students met with scientists from three different research divisions. In the Worm Department, they viewed cloned worms which are used for research in the central nervous system, valued at \$14 million. Students experienced the strength of the MRI used to evaluate the research animals when the technician places a chain in front of the opening to the MRI. In the research clinic for Sjogren's syndrome the group learned about a condition in which some people cannot salivate, cry, or sweat. Mrs. McLain, Mrs. Napier, and Mr. & Mrs. Sharp led the students on this educational adventure.
