


FCCLA CRUSH FUNDRAISER

Ronny's Soup (monthly): *Creamy Potato*

1 (30 oz.) bag frozen hash-brown potatoes (I used cubed.)

2 (14 oz.) cans chicken broth (see Note)

1 (10.75 oz.) can cream of chicken soup

½ cup chopped onion

½ teaspoon ground black pepper (more to taste)

1 (8oz) package cream cheese (softened)

(Optional Toppings: cheese, bacon, green onions)

- 1.) In a slow cooker, combine potatoes, chicken broth, soup, onion, and pepper.
- 2.) Cover and cook on low for 5-6 hours. If your potatoes are still in big chunks you need to cook it longer. They will start falling apart when it's ready.
 - 3.) Add the cream cheese and cook 30 minutes or until cream cheese is melted, stirring occasionally, until combined.
 - 4.) If desired top with cheese, bacon, or sliced green onions.

Note: This soup is creamy and thick.
Add more broth or milk to thin to
preferred consistency.



Bernie in Tulsa

Bernie was in Tulsa, OK this past week. His event was held at the Cox Business Center in downtown Tulsa. By the time the doors opened at 4 p.m., the line to see the Democratic presidential candidate was at least 1,000 people long. It went from the Cox Business Center to past the BOK Center at Second Street and Denver Avenue. Sanders spoke at a "Future to Believe in Tulsa Rally".
