How to make Pumpkin Bread: By: Iyannah Johnson

Ingredients:

- 1 can pumpkin puree
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 1/2 cup apple sauce
- 2/3 cup apple juice
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 3 cups flour
- 1/2 cup buckwheat flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger

Instructions:

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees
2. Grease and flour baking pans
3. In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs, juice, apple sauce, oil, and pumpkin puree
4. In another mixing bowl, stir together the dry ingredients
5. Combine wet and dry ingredients
6. Pour batter into baking pans, filling about half full
7. Bake at 350 for 50 minutes on center oven rack. Bread is done when a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean.

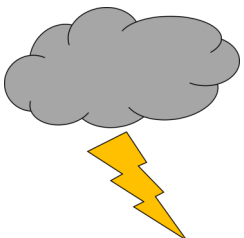
