# We Dedicate . . .

Bill grew up in the small town of Wakefield. It was like many small towns across America. This town stretched from the west hill where the water tower and school house were down east to the grain elevator by the railroad tracks, bordered by the Republican River. Most of the businesses were on main street or a block either side and the residences were spread out beyond. It was a self sufficient little town with everything one would need from the cradle to the grave, that is a doctor's office to a funeral home.

Bill would probably have grown up to work in one of the local filling stations or work for some farmer — but something happened to change all that. In December, 1941, the Japanese attacked the American Fleet at Pearl Harbor and the country was immediately at war. Of course Bill enlisted — not in the Army but in the glamor division — the Air Corps. He adjusted easily to Army life, where there was ample time to lay around the barracks and shoot the breeze. Each raid where they were from and what life was like there, Bill became close friends with his pilot buddy (Bill was a bombardier) and he told about the sleepy little town of Wakefield he came from. Nothing ever happened there. Bill and his Army buddy decided to make something happen!

In that darkest hour before the dawn, Bill and his pilot buddy crawled out of the barracks, took one of the blue bombers, and headed northeast. They came over the hill at the water tower and schoolhouse just as dawn was breaking, dropped down to treetop level and roared down main street, landing light flashing.

Bill had forgotten to tell his pilot buddy about the steeples of the Congregational Church about halfway down, but the pilot saw it this time and tipped his wings and missed it. They rose again over the grain elevator, banked at the Republican River, and came roaring back up town. By now the town was awake, they had marauded out of their beds and came out onto the street, some in their night clothes.

Some women shouted that the Germans were attacking, but for the young people and children, it was high adventure. They saw the airplane climb for the water tower and disappear to the west. Something had happened in Wakefield that Sunday morning!

I never did hear if Bill and his friend got in trouble over that, but the students of Wakefield High School earned their football team the "Blue Bombers" that fall. Bill got through the war and returned to paint houses. He wasn't afraid of high places.
