2 **Parental Involvement In the Title I Program**

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4 The school district will jointly develop with parents a School-Parent-Student Compact that
5 outlines shared responsibility for improved student academic achievement.

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7 The school district recognizes the unique needs of students who are being served in its Title I
8 program, and the importance of parental involvement in the Title I program. Parental
9 Involvement in the Title I Program shall include, *but is not limited to*:

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11 1. An annual meeting to which all parents of participating children will be invited.
12 Invitations may take the form of notes sent with students or announcements in the
13 school newsletter. Additional meetings may be scheduled, based upon need and
14 interest for such meetings.
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16 2. An explanation of the details for the child's participation including but not limited to:
17 curriculum objectives, type and extent of participation, parental input in educational
18 decisions, coordination and integration with other district programs, and evaluations of
19 progress.

21 3. Opportunities for parent training such as training on ways to support children's learning.
22 This opportunity may include, but is not limited to, attendance at the annual Nebraska
23 State Title I Parent Involvement Conference. The goal of these parent activities is to
24 provide parents with opportunities to participate in decisions relating to the education of
25 their students, where appropriate.

27 4. The district will, to the extent practicable, provide parents of limited English proficiency,
28 parents with disability, and parents of migratory children with opportunities for
29 involvement in the Title I program. Communication to parents about student progress
30 will be provided in the language used in the home to the extent practicable. Responses
31 to parent concerns will be provided in a timely manner.

33 5. Opportunities for parent-teacher conferences, in addition to those regularly scheduled by
34 the school district, if requested by the parents or as deemed necessary by school district
35 staff.
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37 6. The district will coordinate and integrate parental involvement programs and activities
38 with other programs in the community. These may include cooperation with other
39 community programs such as Head Start and preschools and other community services
40 such as the public library.

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42 This policy shall be reviewed annually at the annual meeting where concerned parties can have
43 a conversation about possible changes to the Parental Involvement Policy and either (1) alter
44 the policy and adopted it as altered, or (2) reaffirm the policy, following a public hearing.
