4 Any manner of dress, hair style, make up, or personal cleanliness, that
5 constitutes a threat to the safety, health, welfare, or morals of the student or
6 others; that violates any statute; that interferes with the education process, or
7 that school officials can reasonably predict will interfere with the education
8 process; or that causes or may cause excessive maintenance problems in the
9 school, may be grounds for corrective or disciplinary action. The superintendent
10 or designee may institute specific dress code regulations in any school consistent
11 with board policy.
