The *Institutions with Practical Nursing Programs*, above, have agreed to grant advanced standing to students completing the Health Occupations program from participating area technical schools according to all provisions outlined in the General Articulation Agreement as well as the following criteria:

1. Program prerequisites as established by the receiving institution shall be met.
2. A grade of "B" or better will have been earned in the course(s), including mastery of all nurse assistant competencies (list attached), for which articulation credit or advanced standing is to be granted.
3. The technical school program instructor and counselor or director must complete a Recommendation for Articulated College Credit form to be submitted directly to the institution where the student is applying.
4. Enrollment must be initiated within **one (1)** year of high school graduation or completion of the technical school program.*

* Students who enroll after one year from their high school graduation will have their credit evaluated on an individual basis.
