# All Children:

- Advantus Super Stacker Stackable Pencil Box (8 ¼ x 3 ¾ x 1 ½) or a box about the same size.
- Backpack large enough to fit a folder, library books, and a book baggie. It is also helpful if it is large enough to hold extra clothes and unneeded clothes, depending on the season.
- Gallon size bag of spare clothes. Please include shorts, pants, t-shirt, two pair of socks, and two pair of underwear.
- Indoor shoes this may be hard soled slippers, slip on shoes, or velcro tennis shoes (they can have ties, if your child knows how to tie their shoes). These shoes will stay at school.
