APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Mr. Hall moved to approve the Agenda. Mr. Frazier seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.

DRESS CODE: The Board had a discussion about the Dress Code. There were two parents that made comments in regards to the Dress Code.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Mr. Hall moved that the Board enter Executive Session for Personnel and Contractual Matters. Mr. Frazier Seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.
