

STATION ROTATION

Instructional Strategy


The **Station Rotation** model allows students to rotate through stations on a fixed schedule, where at least one of the stations is an online learning station. During a 90-minute instructional block, for example, students in small, differentiated groups rotate across learning stations at 30-minute intervals:

- Group 1 = Teacher-Led (Small Group) Instruction
- Group 2 = Independent & Collaborative Practice
- Group 3 = Personalized, Online Instruction


