03-24-2016 School Board Minutes

The Lamesa Board of Trustees met in a regular meeting on Thursday, March 24, 2016, in the Board Room.

Regina Crutcher represented the Lamesa *Press Reporter*.

There were no students to be recognized.

Albert Martinez made the motion to approve the minutes of February 18, 2016, budget amendments, and ratification of bills as presented. Rebecca Gonzales seconded it. It passed by a vote of 7-0.

All Principals present gave their campus reports.

Executive Director of Finance and Operations did not have any informational items to be discussed.

Superintendent Knight will discuss LOCAL Policy 104 Update at the next meeting. Mr. Knight stated he was appointed to serve on the TAMS (Texas Association of Midsized Schools) to represent approximately 12 to 13 schools from Region 17. His commission starts in June 2016. Knight also gave a brief summary of the Construction update.

Executive Director of Special and Federal Programs Melissa Oliva discussed the 21st Century Grant Application for Cycle 9 and the Application for High Quality Pre-K Grant.

President Raney opened the floor for public hearing to discuss Amendment No. 1 to Limitation on Appraised Value Agreement between the District and BNB Lamesa Solar LLC. No one signed up. Ms. Raney closed the hearing. Rebecca Gonzales made the motion to approve the Amendment No. 1 to Limitation on Appraised Value Agreement between the District and BNB Lamesa Solar LLC, as presented thereby further modify the limitation on Appraised Value Agreement dated July 7, 2015, and authorize the Board President or other available Board Officer to execute the Amendment No. 1 on behalf of the District and to take such other action as may be required under Chapter 313 of the Texas Tax Code or the Controller's related rules. Kelli Merritt seconded it. It passed by a vote of 7-0.

Albert Martinez made the motion to delegate the Superintendent final hiring authority for Chapter 21 employees from the months of April 1, 2016 through August 31, 2016. Ernest Ogeda seconded it. It passed by a vote of 7-0.

Don Bethel made the motion to adjourn. Rebecca Gonzales seconded it. It passed by a vote of 7-0.
