Teacher 1 Salary and Benefits 4.5 hours per week X 32 weeks at a stipend of \$25.00 per hour. The \$25.00 includes salary and benefits)	\$3,600	Teacher 1 will teach Spanish to 3 rd , 4 th , and 5 th grade students 2 mornings a week from 8:15-8:50 for a total of 140 minutes per week. The remaining 130 minutes per week will be to prep for the lessons.
Teacher 2 Salary and Benefits 4.5 hours per week X 32 weeks at a stipend of \$25.00 per hour. The \$25.00 includes salary and benefits)	\$3,600	Teacher 2 will teach a math magic class to K,1,2 nd grade one day per week and 3 rd , 4 th , and 5 th grade students one morning per week, from 8:15-8:50 for a total of 140 minutes per week. The remaining 130 minutes per week will be to prep for the lessons.
Before School Supplies	\$1,045.77	This money is set aside to purchase the supplies needed for both the Spanish and Math classes.

Goal, Action, and Assessment Plan Spanish	Families may choose to participate in the Spanish program. Students in the program will be pre-and post tested quarterly for the purpose of showing growth in Spanish and English vocabulary, and comprehension. Students may choose to participate both brick and mortar and online. All lessons will be loaded onto the online learning platform so students that miss their before school lesson
	will have access to it and can work on it from home. The Spanish lesson focus will be on vocabulary fluency and language and reading comprehension. Goal: Students will either show 10% growth from pre to post test or a Mastery Score of 80% or higher on the post test.
Goal, Action, and Assessment Plan Math	Families may choose to participate in the Math Magic program. Students in the program will be pre-and post tested quarterly for the purpose of showing growth in Math Fluency. (Grade level math content and math fact fluency) Writing and language will be integrated into the program through the use of math journals and math talks. Students may choose to participate both brick and mortar and online. All lessons will be loaded onto the online learning platform so students that miss their before school lesson will have access to it and can work on it from home. The Math Magic program focus will be on math fluency in the areas of counting and cardinality, and numbers and operations in base 10. Goal: Students will either show 10% growth from pre to post test or a Mastery Score of 80% or higher on the post test.
