

Academic and Career Planning Services/Education for Employment Annual Notice

The St. Croix Central School District Education for Employment program includes multiple vocational learning opportunities for students including career awareness at the elementary school levels, career exploration at the middle school levels, and career planning and preparation at the high school levels. Academic and Career Planning (ACP), guided by building counselors, occurs at the middle school and at the high school for all students. Education for Employment includes program options such as coursework in Computer Science, Business, and Agriculture Science; student organizations such as Future Farmers of America (FFA) and Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA); school-based enterprises such as Panther Pizza, Panther Catering, and Panther Construction; and outside of school work opportunities through Youth Apprenticeship and School-To-Work.
