Happy New Year! Hard to believe it is already almost February...

You may have been watching, but if not you likely heard and have been following the progress of Buffalo Bills safety Damar Hamlin following his collapse and subsequent cardiac arrest on the field after making a tackle on Monday Night Football January 2nd. Medical professionals on the field were able to restart Hamlin's heart while administering CPR and using an automated external defibrillator (AED). Such an occurrence can happen anywhere and to anyone, which is why each Perry School building has at least one AED and has staff trained in its use as well as CPR, with additional staff training in the coming weeks.
