The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$3,453.73, Escrow checks totaling \$293,710.97, Cooperative checks totaling 9,776.50 and Activity checks totaling \$9,281.76.

The Elementary Principal reported that most cabinets have been installed. Flooring has begun and the epoxy floors will be put down July 22nd. Interviews for the kitchen position was held. Jonathan Risor was hired for the full time cook position. Tammy Johnson will be assisting in the kitchen from 10:30 a.m. till 1:30 p.m.

The Superintendent reported that the Knox County Fair is August 8th – 11th, fall sports practice will begin on August 12th. Teacher work days will be August 13 and 14 and the first day of school will be on August 15th. August board meetings will be August 19th with a budget workshop to be held on August 28th. Phase 3 remodeling is going well. The hood in the FCS kitchen is currently being installed. Ceiling grids are finishing up. Surface Sealers will be here on July 22 to start putting down the epoxy floors. An additional cabinet in the kindergarten room and choral robe cabinets will installed. Staff and student handbooks have been updated. The faculty handbook will be finalized once all hires have been made. Kersten Auto has found a 2018 Nissan Altima.

There were no Committee reports.

The Board discussed the upcoming school year, construction updates, student & faculty handbooks, 2019-2020 bus routes, and future planning to get into compliance with ADA and Title 9. The building and grounds committee will need to meet to determine future projects and timelines.
