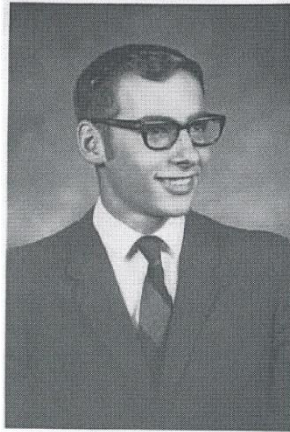


Richard Duerre Memorial Scholarship

The Outstanding Senior Football Player Award

Description:

This award was established by the Duerre family and the Bristol High School Class of 1970 in memory of Richard Duerre. Richard was a member of the Bristol



Pirates Football team #62. He was an asset to his team and an All-Conference Football Player. He loved the game and was a team player. Richard was diagnosed with leukemia during the fall football season of his senior. Richard graduated in May 1970, but just mere months later, he died December 1, 1970 at the age of 18. His memory will live on through his love of football and this award!

Eligibility Criteria:

- The annual award will go to an outstanding Groton Area High School senior football player who plans to attend a vocational school or college.
- Selection will be based on:
 - performance
 - team spirit
 - love of the sport.

Application requirements:

- Fill out the local scholarship form.
 - Answer questions,
 - short essay
 - 2 recommendations
- Write a ½ - 1-page essay addressing the topic below

Essay Topic:

Please write a short essay on why you love the game of football and what you have learned from being part of the football team.

Other:

The recipient's name will appear on the Richard Duerre Award Plaque. The nominee will also receive a scholarship which will be awarded during the athletic banquet.
