What is IDD Supports Coordination?

Intellectual Developmental Disability (IDD) Supports Coordination is a system of supports and coordination of services to individuals with diagnoses of IDD and their families.

Supports Coordinators assist their consumers, as well as the consumer's family, to reach a satisfactory quality of life by coordinating for a system of care. Our Supports Coordinators identify a person's strengths and help to build on those skills toward the goals of improved self-sufficiency and independence.

Supports Coordinators develop a partnership of respect, support, and collaboration with consumers and their families. Within this partnership, our Supports Coordinators develop an individual support plan and help consumers and families:

- Link to chosen treatment, other services, natural supports, community resources, and opportunities that are specified in the consumer's Individual Service Plan (ISP)
- Address basic physical needs and supports that are necessary for a stable, safe, and healthy community life
- Provide skill development and training services that enable consumers to

perform daily living activities such as budgeting and accessing financial services; meal planning and obtaining food; securing safe housing, home maintenance, and housekeeping; accessing transportation; exploring, securing, or maintaining employment, and problem-solving skills, in general.

• Connect consumers and family to kindred, peer, and other social support networks that are important to the persons served.

Who is Eligible?

Consumers who have a diagnosis of Intellectual Developmental Disability and documentation of an IQ of 70 or below are eligible for supports coordination.

IDD Supports Coordination is not dependent on income. However, some services that Supports Coordinators might arrange could be dependent on income. Eligibility can be determined during the intake process by Service Access and Management, Inc. Staff.



What Services can be Provided?

Services are based on an approved plan and can include the following:

- Residential Services
 - Community Homes
 - · Family Living/Life Sharing
 - Supported Living
- Day Services
 - Adult Training Programs
 - Vocational Rehabilitation
 - Job Finding and Job Support
- Home Based/Family Support Services
 - Respite Care
 - Individual Habilitation

- To provide quality supports and quality information through monitoring of the health and safety of people receiving supports and services.
- To link consumers to services, resources and benefits.
