All meetings of the Governing Board are open to the public; however participation of the public is at the discretion and pleasure of the Board. The Board may not discuss or take action on any item not listed on the agenda (A.R.S. 38-431.01).

Personal attacks upon Board members, staff personnel, or other persons in attendance or absent by individuals who address the Board are discouraged. Presenters are cautioned that statements or representations concerning others that convey an unjustly unfavorable impression may subject the presenter to civil action for defamation. Policies KE, KEB, KEC, and KED are provided by the Board for disposition of legitimate complaints, including those involving individuals.

Any employee who wishes to address the Board in the employee's capacity as a parent, District resident, or individual, rather than as an employee, may do so. An employee may not communicate on school or employment-related matters during the Call To The Public. They must first communicate their concerns at the administrative level. Any employee who exhausts the opportunity of discussing a matter at the various administrative levels may then communicate with the Board on the matter in writing (Policy BHC).
