Dear Board President, Members, Superintendent, and Clerk:

Current legislation requires the President of the BOCES Board to name a single date between April 16 and 30 on which all components will meet to vote on the BOCES Administrative Budget and elect BOCES Board members. In compliance with those regulations, the BOCES Board President, Candace Clemens set Tuesday, April 16, 2019 as the date. Please review your schedule of meetings and consider either moving one of your regular meetings to the 16th or schedule a special meeting.

This year, three BOCES Board members' terms will expire. They are Ralph Kerr of Area 3, Robert Keenan of Area 7 and Steve Crowley of Area 8. Area 3 represents Belfast, Cuba-Rushford, and Fillmore. Area 7 represents Franklinville, Hinsdale, and West Valley. Area 8 represents Ellicottville and Salamanca. BOCES Board members elected to fill the vacancies will serve a three-year term.

. In order to qualify to be a BOCES Board candidate, individuals:

- Must reside within the boundaries of a component school district. To continue the agreement for area representation, candidates should be residing in the area they will represent.
- Cannot be an employee of a component district.
- No more than one candidate may be elected per component district. A candidate need not be a member of a component district school board to be nominated or elected by that board.

Nominations are by school board resolution and the names of the nominees should be submitted to the BOCES District Clerk, Colleen Jimerson, BOCES Center at Olean, 1825 Windfall Road, Olean, NY 14760 by March 22, 2019. This information may be hand-carried, mailed, or faxed (716-376-8452).

Election ballots containing the slate of candidates for election to the BOCES Board will be sent to each component district, by the BOCES Clerk, at least fourteen (14) days prior to the election.

Voting on candidates for election to seats on the BOCES Board will occur on Tuesday, April 16, 2019. Each component board is entitled to cast one vote per vacancy but no more than one vote per candidate. There must be a quorum of board members voting in each district to have a valid ballot. Failure of a component district to obtain a quorum to vote will result in a voided ballot. A component district <u>may not vote on a different date</u>. Any vote cast on a day other than April 16th <u>will be void</u>.

Voting on the Administrative Budget will occur at the same meeting on April 16th. Each board is allowed one vote for or against the budget. The Administrative Budget must be approved by resolution of a majority of component districts actually voting. Failure to approve the Administrative Budget will result in a contingency budget being adopted. No second vote can be taken. Each component district must transmit their adopted resolution for the Administrative Budget and their vote for the vacant BOCES seats to the District Superintendent's office not later than April 17th which is one business day after the vote.

The 2019 BOCES Annual Meeting has been set for Wednesday, April 3 at 7 p.m. at the Center at Olean. Dinner will be served at 6 p.m. for all board members, administrators, district clerks and others who wish to attend. At this meeting, the various BOCES budgets will be reviewed in detail and opportunities for questions will be offered. Candidates seeking election to the BOCES Board will be afforded an opportunity to speak to his or her candidacy if so inclined. If you plan to attend, please notify your superintendent who will be forwarding the reservations to us no later than March 22, 2019.

Copies of a sample resolution and a certification form for voting on the BOCES budget and a list of BOCES Board members are included for your review. Copies of the 2019-2020 tentative budgets will be mailed to your superintendent by March 22, 2019. Superintendent will distribute the budget to their respective board members.

The entire BOCES Board and staff look forward to seeing you at the Annual Meeting on April 3rd.

The Andover Central School District recognizes that mental health is a state of well-being in which every individual realizes one's potential, can cope with normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to contribute to one's community. It is a dimension of overall health. As part of overall health and wellness, mental health includes: a sense of self-esteem and self-confidence; the ability to identify, express and regulate emotions; the ability to set and achieve goals; recognition of one's creative skills; the ability to expand knowledge and skills; the ability to feel and show empathy for others; and the ability to create and maintain satisfying relationships. Schools play a key role in promoting mental health in all children and young people, recognizing that student's learning and development is supported by environments that promote mental health. The impact is the greatest when all staff is involved in mental health promotion as it relates to every area of the school – the culture, policies, curriculum and activities. This policy is intended as guidance to all staff, including non-teaching staff and volunteers. It should be read in conjunction with the medical policy in cases where a student's mental health overlaps with or is linked to a medical issue, district confidentiality policies, policies for students with identified special education needs, and other related mental health policies (e.g., wellness, student support and discipline, including alternatives).

The policy affirms our commitment to providing safe, welcoming and supportive environments that promotes a culture of respect and equity; embeds social and emotional learning into the curriculum, including mental health instruction in Health Education programs; ensures families, students and staff are key partners in mental health and wellbeing initiatives; and works collaboratively with local health professionals and the community.

The goals of the Andover Central School District to accomplish these are to:

- Promote positive mental health for all staff and students;
- Educate and support the school community on a variety of approaches that are culturally sensitive to support mental health;
- Increase the skills of students, staff, parents and school community to recognize signs of mental health conditions;
- Decrease stigma related to talking about mental health;
- Provide support to staff through trainings including ways to recognize when students are experiencing mental health challenges;
- Link students and families to a range of available supports;
- Provide guidance and resources to parents/guardians on how to talk to their children about mental health; and
- Provide support to students living with mental health challenges, their peers, parents and caregivers.

Teaching and Supporting Mental Health

The mental health component of the health education curriculum will be developed by the appropriate school instructional staff and district mental health support staff to ensure that school staff has appropriate knowledge and support to address mental health challenges both preventively and responsively. When appropriate, staff will be encouraged to collaborate with qualified community

mental health professionals. This policy and related supports and curriculum will be consistent with the principles of the whole child and whole school approaches, including multi-tiered support frameworks, and will be offered within a safe and culturally-sensitive environment.

The Andover Central School District's approaches will reflect an understanding that mental health literacy includes four key components:

- · How to obtain and maintain positive mental health;
- Ways to prevent mental health challenges and disorders, identify symptoms of disorders, and the range of available supports and treatments;
- Decrease stigma and promote appropriate help-seeking behavior; and
- Increase understanding of the challenges of mental health conditions in everyday life.

Elements of positive mental health include: An understanding of the elements of positive mental health, reducing stigma and promoting recovery including strengthening social determinants of health, and personal resources such as engaging with learning at school; connecting with family, peers and community; believing in one's ability to learn and engage with others; ensuring equitable access to opportunities to learn and engage; and strengthening capacity to advocate for a healthier environment.

Staff will receive regular training about supporting mental health, recognizing, and responding to mental health needs in a developmentally (to include students with special needs) appropriate and culturally sensitive way. The school district will support districtwide professional development on integrating mental health education into the curriculum, and in accessing resources, tools and professional learning to enhance their knowledge and capacity to integrate mental health and well-being content across the curriculum. The Integrating Mental Health Policy will be distributed through all schools in the district and posted online.

Implementing and Evaluating the Policy on Mental Health

The District will establish an implementation and evaluation plan for this policy to monitor its effectiveness and the possible need for modification over time. Towards this end, the District designates the following staff to have operational responsibility for ensuring that the District meets the goals and mandates of this policy. The district designates the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Staff Development and the School Principal to have operational responsibility. These designated staff, including school mental health support staff, will also serve as liaisons with community agencies that may help with providing resources. The District will annually report on the progress toward meeting the goals of the policy to the School Board, wellness committee, building principal and school health services personnel. The Andover Central School District recognizes that every member of Andover Central School District has an impact on student health and contributes to creating an environment that promotes positive mental health and well-being. All members of our school community - including students, teachers, support staff, school related professionals, administrators, school board, families and volunteers, will be supported in their efforts to provide an environment that promotes mental health. The Andover Central School District curriculum will integrate the multiple dimensions of health by including mental health and the relation of physical and mental health so as to enhance student

understanding, attitudes and behaviors that promote health, well-being and human dignity throughout K-12.

The Board of Education (BOE) shall promote necessary district-wide staff awareness and understanding of the Mental Health Education policy by:

- Having it reviewed by the Policy Committee and then adopted in Public Session by the BOE;
- . Distributing the policy and making it available online; and
- Supporting district-wide professional development on integrating mental Health Education into the curriculum.

The BOE shall promote necessary community awareness of the Mental Health Education Policy by the following:

• Discussing the change and supports available at a meeting(s) of the BOE; and

The School District will:

- Provide a curriculum that actively engages and builds students' self-awareness, social awareness, responsible decision-making, self-management and relationship skills, and social and emotional learning;
- Support staff in accessing resources, tools and professional learning to enhance their knowledge and capacity to integrate mental health and well-being content across the curriculum;
- Highlighting the curriculum change in the district newsletter.
- Establish a whole school, whole child approach to mental health that is consistent with this policy by providing positive, safe and supportive environments and opportunities to build and practice relationship skills, resilience and social and emotional competencies;
- Engage an advisory committee such as a Wellness or similar committee in supporting efforts; and
- Engage students, families and the community in supporting mental health and well-being in a culturally-sensitive approach.

Monitoring and Review of Policy

The Mental Health Education Policy and related curriculum will be monitored and reviewed annually by Andover Central School District Wellness Team, including: CSE Chairperson, Social Worker, School Counselor, & School Psychologist.
