

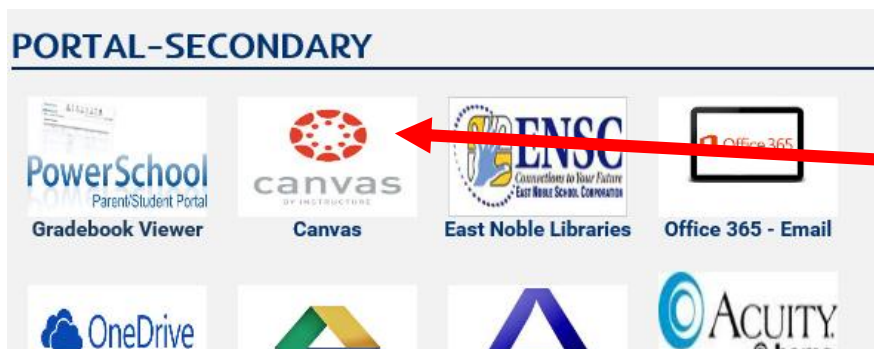
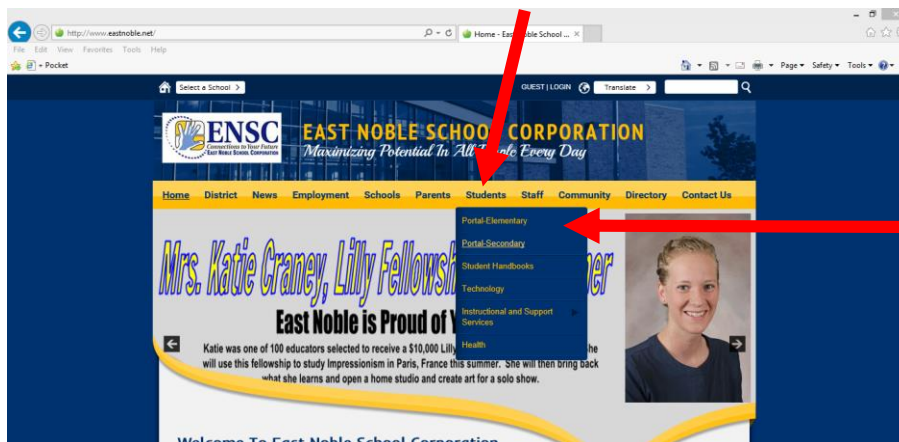
CANVAS TUTORIAL FOR STUDENTS

Introduction

Canvas is the Learning Management System (LMS) used by East Noble School District. This LMS allows teachers to create digital curriculum for students to access while at school or home. You will use Canvas to download files, take quizzes, access links to other sites or watch imbedded videos. Canvas works in any browser, but if you find it not loading in one browser then please try another. Browsers currently used to access Canvas successfully at home are Chrome and Firefox.

Student Access to Canvas

Canvas can be accessed through any of the school building websites. The direct corporation link is www.eastnoble.net. From here, select the "Students" drop down then "Student Portal".

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1. Global Navigation across the top of page.
2. To Do: Late assignments
3. Coming up: Assignments that are due in the future
4. Recent Feedback: Scores and comments from the teacher on assignments already turned in.
5. Recent Activity: Assignments that have been added to courses and notifications from discussions.

How to View my Courses
