Resolution – Affordable Care Act

WHEREAS, the Andover Central School District maintains a group health plan for its employees ("health plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Andover Central School District is required to offer coverage under its health plan to eligible full-time employees pursuant to the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act ("ACA") effective in 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Andover Central School District employs persons for variable hours whose full-time status must be determined pursuant to guidance issued under the ACA beginning on July 1, 2015,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Andover Central School District hereby is, authorized and directed to establish and maintain procedures for the purpose of compliance with the ACA, including but not limited to the following:

- 1. For variable-hour employees, the Andover Central School District shall establish a 12-month standard measurement period beginning May 1 and ending the following April 30;
- 2. The initial measurement period for new variable-hour employees shall be the 12-month period beginning on the date of hire and ending on the anniversary date thereof;
- 3. The administrative period following the standard measurement period is the period beginning May 1 and ending June 30;
- 4. The administrative period for new hires will begin at the end of the initial measurement period and end the first of the month following 30 days after the anniversary of hire, at which point the initial stability period shall begin;

- 5. The stability period, during which time a variable-hour employee's status as eligible or ineligible for health plan coverage is fixed, is the period beginning July 1 and ending June 30.
