

Out-of-State Student Enrollment and Tuition

In order to be fiscally sound, Daggett School District (DSD) wants every enrolled student to generate revenue from the State of Utah through the applicable Weighted Pupil Unit (WPU) formula or through the State of Wyoming tuition. Additionally, DSD has publicly stated that it will do nothing to undermine the viability of local Wyoming schools.

Wyoming Tuition

The District has a standing agreement with Sweetwater County School District #2 (Sweetwater) that DSD schools are the home school for all students living in Washam, Wyoming. Sweetwater agrees to pay the Wyoming per-pupil expenditure rate according to the Average Daily Membership (ADM) formula. That rate is subject to approval by the DSD Board of Education (the Board) in an open meeting of the Board each year.

At the request of the parents/guardians of McKinnon students seeking to enroll in DSD schools, Sweetwater has a standing agreement with the DSD Board that Sweetwater will pay the Wyoming per-pupil expenditure rate according to the ADM formula for students 5th grade and above.

Students living in other parts of Wyoming may attend DSD schools and the DSD Board will accept the Wyoming per-pupil expenditure rate according to either the ADM or Average Daily Attendance (ADA) formulae. The rate is subject to approval by the DSD Board of Education in an open meeting of the Board each year.

For students from Wyoming seeking enrollment in DSD schools who are outside of the above described parameters (for example, McKinnon students in Kindergarten through 4th grade), tuition is still required payable either by the State of Wyoming or by the parents at the going Wyoming rate for Sweetwater per-pupil expenditure based on the ADM formula. Three year olds in Pre-School and 4 year olds in Pre-Kindergarten are not eligible for the no-cost programs offered by DSD to Daggett County residents.

Tuition Waiver

For DSD employees only, the DSD Board may, under special circumstances, grant a tuition waiver. Tuition waivers will not be granted for any other reason.

DSD Sponsored Afterschool Programs

Students from Wyoming who are not enrolled in DSD schools who want to participate in DSD sponsored afterschool programs (for example, Choir; Theater; MES recreational sports—swimming, soccer, basketball, baseball; other) may do so.

No transportation will be provided.
