Andes Central Indian Education Committee Meeting October 16, 2018 ACHS DDN Room 103

The meeting was called to order by Vice - Chairperson Mary Antelope-Stotz at 6:11PM.

Members present included: Mary Antelope-Stotz, April Long, Candace Dvorak, and Tim Medicine Horn. Tammy Swanson, Kenny St. Pierre, and Debera Lucas were also in attendance.

Mary led the group in an opening prayer.

April moved and Candace seconded to adopt the agenda with an addition. Vote: 4-0 in favor.

April moved and Candace seconded to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Vote: 4-0 in favor.

Kenny shared that he and Alicia are working with Laken Designs for the graphics above the locker areas in the new building. There was a bullying prevention assembly today for Middle School/High School students. There were team building activities as well. Kenny took his Native studies class to the Indian Education Summit in Pierre in September. He has just completed the JH football season with a 4-6-1 record. Deb reported on student enrollment. Thing are close to where they were last year (317) with 34 preschool aged students. The building project is progressing as planned.

The committee reviewed the Title VI evaluation. When reviewing the information Deb explained that the comparison of assessment data (Native American Students and All students) included data from the colony classrooms. She shared what the differences would be when looking at proficiency only within the town schools. This had reading (grades 3-8 and 11) scores go from a difference of -15%(all students vs Native American students) to -.24%. In math, the difference went from -16% to -7.69%. Candace moved and April seconded to receive the evaluation results. Vote: 4-0 in favor.

A draft of the FY 19 JOM program was discussed. Deb noted that there was a \$5,000 carryover from the previous year. Notification was given that the budget for the upcoming year is \$16,815.60. This allowed for \$21,815.60 to be budgeted. All programs will be continued from previous years. A discussion was held regarding reviewing procedures for supply reimbursement as well as providing supports for drug awareness activities. April moved and Candace seconded to approve the JOM program as submitted. Vote: 4-0 in favor.

Candace moved and April seconded to approve shoe reimbursements for 5 high school students, and one middle school student. Vote: 4-0 in favor.

Committee membership was discussed. April moved and Mary seconded to appoint Candace Dvorak to a two (2) year term. Vote: 3-0-1. Motion passed. April moved and Mary seconded to appoint Tim Medicine Horn to a three (3) year term. Vote: 3-0-1. Motion passed. Patrons will be sought for consideration of the vacant one year term. This will be discussed at next month's meeting.

Proposed topics for next month's meeting include: FY 18 JOM evaluation, Stepping Stone Grant Update: Vacant Committee Position, Star Quilts for Graduation, and JOM Program Procedures.

The next proposed meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 7th at 5:00 PM.

Candace moved and April seconded to adjourn at 7:16 PM. Vote: 4-0 in favor.
