Referendum to Maintain Educational Programs & Operations

Based on supportive feedback on the community survey, the Board of Education has scheduled a November 8, 2022 operating referendum. The referendum will ask residents to allow the district to exceed the state's revenue limits by \$980,000 annually for three years. The funding would be used only as needed to maintain current programming and operations amid rising costs and stagnant state aid and enrollment. If approved, the referendum would help ALL schools and students while keeping taxes through 2025 below the 2020-2021 rate.

TAX IMPACT

If voters approve the referendum, WASD's projected school property tax rate through 2025 would remain below the 2020-2021 level. The district's mill rate has dropped 33% since 2013-14.
