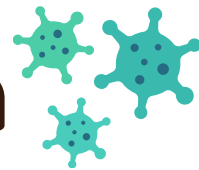

Youth Apprenticeship Program

Youth Apprenticeship is open to all juniors and seniors. Current sophomores are eligible to start the program right away this summer. For those of you that are looking for a full or part-time summer job, you may be eligible to earn these additional benefits at the same time:

- 3.0 HS Credits per year
- Release time from school: juniors can have 1 block per trimester and seniors can have up to 2 blocks. This is optional and you are not required to work during this free block.
- Certificate from the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development. This is great for scholarships or your next job placement.

A QUICK OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAM:

- Use the link above for more information and to apply. There is no obligation when completing the short application. It is really just the first step in collecting some information about your interests.
- The program runs year-round. Once registered, you have one year to work 450 hours. This isn't as difficult as it sounds, especially if you get started this summer.
