TMART (DUNKIN') SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION: HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATING SENIORS

Purpose

The purpose of the TMart Scholarship Program is to provide continued education scholarship awards to student employees / dependents of employees who also provide outstanding experiences in our restaurants.

Awards

The Scholarship Fund will be awarded, in full, for the Fall Semester as decided by a review panel and based on the application content, employment standing, and supervisory management recommendation. The total number of scholarships and amount of individual awards may vary, depending on the specific needs of each applicant. Awards will be granted as a one-time scholarship, but recipients may re-apply future semesters for our Scholarship Fund, as available, in future years. All Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the recipients' college / university.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants FOR FALL SEMESTER, must be attending either a technical school or university for the same semester.
- 2. Applicants must be current employees OR the dependents of current employees and employees must have worked for TMart for at least 45 days.
- 3. Employee applicants or applicants' employed parent must be in good employment standing at the time of application.
- 4. Applicants must be US citizens.

The TMart Scholarship Awards are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin, or sexual orientation. TMart will not award scholarships to applicants who are not qualified and reserves the right not to award a scholarship in a given year.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Applicant (or applicant's parent)'s current employment status at TMart
- 2. Student essay
- 3. Letters of recommendation

Application Requirements

To be considered for a TMart Scholarship Award, applicants must complete an application and return it to our review committee by April 15th. The application must include:

- 1. A completed TMart Scholarship Application Form. Only completed Application Forms will be considered.
- 2. Three letters of recommendation:
 - One from a current or previous teacher.
 - One from a management team member at TMart.
 - One from a co-worker at TMart (or if the applicant is the dependent of an employee, his / her parent employee).
- 3. Proof of Fall enrollment at a college or university.
- 4. A copy of your high school transcript.
- 5. An Essay < 1000 words) stating the applicant's qualifications, educational and career goals, and about their personal experience as a TMart employee or family member of a TMart employee.
- 6. A completed Media Release Form signed by applicant (and guardian, if under 18 years of age).
- 7. Upon availability, we will need a copy of your college tuition bill, in order to process payment.

8. Upon availability, the mailing address / information needed to be included on a check payment for a direct tuition payment to your college or university (this can be obtained from your college / university Cashier's Office), and the relative Student Identification information. Scholarship awards will be paid only to the college / university directly.

THE FIRST SIX ITEMS in the above list must be submitted before the application will be considered.

Submission of Application Form

The Application Form provided is in Word Format. You can fill it out completely electronically, then "Save a Copy" or print and complete by hand. Note that the application requires a signature. You may provide an electronic signature, or print out the completed application, sign it and either scan it as a pdf or mail in the printed application. For the statement of qualifications and education and career goals, you may use the page included in this Application Form, or attach a separate page. Completed application submissions can be:
