High School Senior Scholarship

<u>APPLICATION DEADLINE:</u> April 15th for the year of the scholarship (applications postmarked past this date will not be considered)

The VFW Post 6709 will award scholarships to high school seniors annually as VFW funds are available.

The scholarship will be awarded on academic merit, transcript, service, and written essay. The completed application along with all the required forms can be dropped off to your school guidance counselor.

Application packet will include the following:

- Completed application form
- An attachment listing:
 - Volunteer work/community service/extracurricular activities in the last 4 yrs
 - o Service to Veteran's organization, Veteran, or Veteran's family
 - Your goals in their intended field of study
- Applicant's current high school transcript
- Two-character references from community member's other than principals, teachers, and guidance counselors using character reference form
- 500-1,000-word essay on a Veteran that has special meaning to you and why.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be a graduating senior of a high school or a home school program.
- Eligibility must come from a Wisconsin VFW member in good standing. The applicant must have a parent, grandparent or great-grandparent who is a member of Bentley-Hull Post 6709. VFW Post 6709 members who are deceased will be considered if they were current in the year of their death.
- The student must plan on attending a trade, technical, 2 year or 4-year college.
- The student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
