 - EdVisions Off Campus students will show acceptable annual improvements in Mathematics based on NWEA MAP RIT scores. 55.2 % of 7-10 grade EOC students will meet or exceed their NWEA Mathematics RIT target from Spring 2015 to Spring 2016
 - 95% of EdVIsions Off Campus Students will participate in mandatory state testing in MCA Math and Reading
 - EdVisions Off Campus students will demonstrate state average proficiency results on MCA Math and Reading
 - Hope Survey
 - 85% of new students will grow or maintain hope
 - The mean hope score of returning students is greater than 49.6
 - Satisfaction Surveys
 - 75% of students will participate in satisfaction surveys
 - 75% of students will agree that they are satisfied by their progress
 - Achievement Gap
 - No data available, cell sizes smaller than 20
 - Graduation Rates
 - State generated
 - FY15 Graduation rate will be 37.33
 - IOS generated
 - Four-year graduation rate: 95% of students continuously enrolled for four years; 85% of students continuously enrolled for three years; 70% for two years; and 50% for one year.
 - Five-year graduation rate: 85% of students continuously enrolled for five years
- To be implemented in FY 2016: Post-Secondary Plans for students by end of 10th grade
- Creation of a Life Skills Rubric in FY 2015 (was piloted), implementation FY 2016
- Alumni "tracking"- to be implemented FY 2016
