# RANDA Professional Growth Plan -Quick Help

## Building Focus Goal #1

This goal will be developed as a staff. After it has been developed and decided, teachers can follow the steps for goal #2 to record it.

## Professional Practices Goal #2

- 1. Log in to RANDA
- 2. Click on the My Evaluation tab at the top of your dashboard
- 3. Click on the Professional Growth Plan in the Evaluation Tracking Table.
- 4. Once in your growth plan, click on Add a Goal on the right side of the page.
- 5. Type out the *Goal Name*. Use a brief phrase or title for your goal name
  - Examples:
  - i. Increase time in text during universal reading instruction
  - ii. engage students in higher level thinking skills in reading
  - iii. integrate writing in math to explain thinking
  - iv. increase student learning through differentiation
  - v. Increase the use of text-based questioning
- 6. Type out the *Goal Description*. Write a short statement explaining your goal and giving more details about it.

Example: During universal reading instruction, I will utilize time in text reading strategies to increase the amount of time students are actively engaged in reading.

- 7. Next, you will add three action steps (no more than five) you will do to accomplish this goal.
  - a. There is a "+Action Step' button to click on under on the right side of the *Actions Table*.

    You have to add action steps one at a time using the back button between each one.
- 8. Save Goal

#### DO NOT SUBMIT UNTIL YOU HAVE ALL THREE GOALS COMPLETED

- When you have completed all THREE goals you click the box I submit my Professional Growth Plan as part of my evaluation process under the e-signature and click Submit.
- Check your Activity Chart to make sure your Professional Growth Plan is pending. It will say pending instead of complete as it is something you and your principal develop together.

## Curriculum-Based Measures (CBM) Goal #3

It is important to make sure you understand the expectations and rigor for the CBM goal. Please refer to pages 8-11 of the District Evaluation Handbook for more information.

Note: Remember, always use the 'back' button on the RANDA website – not the back arrow in in your browser.

- 1. <u>Plan your curriculum-based measure using the guide in the District Handbook.</u> At a minimum all CBM goals REQUIRE:
  - a. Name/Title of Goal
  - b. Colorado Content Standards being addressed (student standards)
  - c. Identify which Students/Group
  - d. <u>Performance / Student Learning Outcome</u>: *Example: Students will learn a 3 or 4 on the persuasive post-assessment.* Note: Only depth of knowledge 3 or 4 assessments may be used.
  - e. Define Progress Monitoring to be done throughout the year
  - f. <u>Summative Assessme</u>nt This should be a high-quality, standards based assessment. Teacher must describe specifically how the students will be assessed. Teachers cannot use general descriptions such as 'post-assessment' or 'final exam'.
  - g. <u>Scoring Rubric</u> If your assessment requires teacher judgment as a part of the scoring process, a rubric must be developed and submitted as a part of a teacher's CBM.
  - h. <u>Growth Targets/Teacher Ratings</u>: Teachers define the growth targets and ratings for their CMB. \_\_\_\_\_ % of my students met the learning outcome. Teachers define the % for a 1, 2, 3, and 4
    - 1. 1 = 0-49% 2 = 50-65% 3 = 66-88% 4 = 89% or more students met the learning outcome.
    - 2. 1 = 1-40% 2 = 41-70% 3 = 71-90% 4 = 91% or more students met the learning outcome.
- 2. Decide how you will record your CBM
  - a. OPTION #1: Complete the CBM worksheet to guide your thinking. You can enter your CBM directly on this form and upload it to RANDA as part of your third goal.
  - b. OPTION #2: Develop your own description of your CBM, and upload it to RANDA as part of your third goal.
  - c. OPTION #3: Develop your goal and directly type it into RANDA as your third goal.
- 3. Log in to RANDA
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- 5. Click on the Professional Growth Plan in the Evaluation Tracking Table.
- 6. Once in your growth plan, click on Add a Goal on the right side of the page.

- 7. Type out the Goal Name. Use a brief phrase or title for your goal name. Examples:
  - a. CBM Analyze critical events in history
  - b. CBM Growth in Constructed Response in reading
  - c. CBM Compare & Contrast two texts in essay
- 8. Type out the *Goal Description*. Write a short statement explaining your goal and giving more details about it.
  - a. This is where you type in the <u>required</u> components of your CBM if you chose Option #3 above.
  - b. Or, you can choose Option #1 or #2 above, and upload a file. If you choose one of these two, just enter a brief sentence describing your goal
- 9. Next, you will add three action steps (no more than five) you will do to accomplish this goal. The action steps are the 'how' you will get your students to grow.
  - a. There is a "+Action Step' button to click on under on the right side of the *Actions Table*.

    You have to add action steps one at a time using the back button between each one.
