






Academic Performance on the Assessments








English Learners Achieving English Language Proficiency





Maine uses the ACCESS for ELLs suite of assessments as a tool to measure English Learners (ELLs) proficiency in the English language. ACCESS for ELLs is given to all ELs during the annual testing window, which typically takes place from early January through early March.







The spending that does not typically occur at the school, but is necessary for the school to operate. This includes spending on the superintendent, business office staff, and transportation costs.




Personnel and Nonpersonnel Spending





Chronic Absenteeism



Chronic absenteeism is defined as the percent of students that are chronically absent that have been enrolled in a school for at least 10 days and are missing 10% or more of those days. 






Student Improvement over Time on the State Assessments




Science Students At or Above State Expectations by Student Population






