



2. We could be willing to accept more students, but non-resident students will pay additional costs. A tuition rate would need to be determined to do so. The Fayette Budget Comm. has made it clear that they do not feel it would be fair to Fayette taxpayers to pay for non-Fayette students.
3. Update the policy allowing students of FCS staff to attend, i.e. child or grandchild.

J. Swimm asked the Sch. Comm. to follow its' policies when considering the decision. He noted that we are looking at a 1.6 mil increase in the budget this year.

J. Beekman asked if all Supt. Agreement students should be paying tuition?
