Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for the Marlette Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact the building principal, Jason Vislosky, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following web site (<http://bit.ly/2IwmFSG>), or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not given one of these labels.

Marlette Elementary School is continuing to battle the negative effects poverty can have on students' academic proficiency and emotional growth. We are blessed to have a full-time social worker as well as two part-time social workers. As a staff, we believe that we must first address the basic needs of our children before learning can occur. We are creating a strong foundation with our children and their families that will last a lifetime.

**PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL**

2017 & 2018- Resident pupils in grades K-6 are assigned to Marlette Elementary School, as well as K-6 pupils applying under Schools of Choice.

2017 & 2018- Marlette Elementary School continues to focus on student growth and proficiency in Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

**A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL**

2017 & 2018- In addition to offering an exceptional K-6 experience, Marlette Elementary School also offers a developmental kindergarten program, a tuition-based preschool for 3 and 4 year olds, and the Great Start Readiness Program preschool for 4 year olds whose families qualify. We continue to offer before and after school care with our Red Raider Care program.
