Requirements for Special Programs

Honors STEAM Academy

Students can request to be considered for Honors ELA or Math.

Enrollment will be based on a set of criteria that includes grades, STAAR scores, and teacher recommendation.

Admission into the STEAM Academy is by application only and is based on work ethic, attitude, behavior, and attendance.

Band

In the band elective students build on basic music instruction from elementary school and learn to read music and play an instrument. Classes are divided up into brass, woodwind, and percussion, and are full year classes.



Athletics or PE

Students are required to get at least one PE credit in either 7th or 8th grade. If a student is in athletics, this counts as their credit. Students who wish to play Football, Volleyball, Basketball, or Run Track should sign up for athletics. Students who wish to play Golf or Tennis should sign up for those individual sports.







Choir

In the choir elective students build on basic music instruction from elementary school and learn to read music and sing with a group. Students learn to perform music in front of an audience as well.





Theatre

Theatre class teaches a student how to think about stories, understand the character, connect to the dramatic structure, and bring the character to life all while working together. They learn what goes into a production: costume, sounds, set, makeup, props etc. Other benefits of theatre is vocabulary development, memorizing and thinking fast when things don't go the way they should. (It's not just for actors!)






STEAM Elective









Career Explorations



Technology Elective


In the Technology Elective, students will begin with keyboarding instruction. Once they have mastered the keyboard, students will learn how to code and use the Google suite of apps for education.






AVID Elective - Application Only
