The School-Based Health Center at Maranacook High School offers **Expanded Medical Services** to all students in grades 6-12. Our nurse practitioner provides convenient, quality care right here at school and she can work closely with your child's own doctor. These services are provided by MaineGeneral Medical Center.

The nurse practitioner provides the following services:

- Diagnosis and treatment of acute illnesses, such as strep throat or ear infections.
- Routine lab tests.
- Prescription medications.
- Help with chronic conditions, such as asthma.
- Reproductive health care and education for students who are at least 14 years of age.

You may also sign up for **Counseling Services** through the School-Based Health Center. We partner with Kennebec Behavioral Health and Health Affiliates Maine whose licensed professional counselors have years of experience and understand the challenges that teens face.

No student will be denied any of our services based on his/her ability to pay. If you have health insurance, your health insurance company will be billed and you will be responsible for only the copay.
