Reading & Writing Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO :

- Know and apply all phonics/decoding skills
- Read grade level text with accuracy and understanding of meaning
- Understand how prefixes and suffixes effect word meaning
- Through inferences and drawing conclusions formulate a response using at least three examples from the text.
- Write a 3 paragraph essay citing three pieces of text evidence using compound and complex sentences along with standard conventions

Mathematics Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO :

- Memorize Multiplication Facts (0-12)
- Write in expanded form up to hundred thousands
- Use attributes to determine area and perimeter of shapes
- Identify fractions with denominators of 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 10
- Understand values of numbers in ten-thousands, thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones places

Patriot Foundations Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO :

- Successfully converse on a given topic that includes elaboration and justification on their viewpoints, while identifying alternate viewpoints. This communication can be verbal or written.
- Create solutions to problems, both independently and in a group. Students will experiment with one or two step solutions and record results
- Students leaving 3rd grade will be able to work with a group to complete projects with assigned roles and responsibilities while helping others complete given tasks.
- Create unique ideas/works, productively use time allotted to complete assignments, and use feedback from teachers/peers to improve their work
- Show compassion, manage their own feelings to not effect others, be respectful and attentive in class, and take responsibility for their actions
- Understand that mistakes are a part of the learning process, manage their frustration, and accept responsibility for individual growth
