Internal Board Policies

Standing Committee on Personnel

It shall be the policy of Minden Public Schools that the Personnel Committee shall consist of at least two members appointed by the Board President in consultation with the Superintendent.

The Personnel Committee will represent the full Board of Education in negotiations with recognized labor organizations. The full Board of Education may also include selected administrators on the negotiations team. The Board of Education reserves the right to appoint a chief spokesperson who is not a member of the Board to represent the Board in negotiations.

After negotiations are completed, the personnel committee will make a recommendation to the full Board of Education on the salary schedule and benefits under consideration.
