Getting Started on the Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund Application Process

Do you qualify for an NOSF scholarship?

There are requirements that must be met to qualify for tuition assistance:

Must be a resident in *Allen, Crawford, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Hancock, Henry, Huron, Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Putnam, Richland, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood or Wyandot Counties*

Children must be entering into the **K-8 grade** for the 2023-2024 school year

Income and household size must meet requirements (see below)

Income Eligibility for the 2023-2024 School Year

Find your income on this chart, and note the percentage of tuition for which you qualify, according to your household size (includes children and adults in house). The maximum scholarship amount is \$2,000 for private school tuition and \$750 for homeschool expenses per year. Please remember that each family must pay at least \$500 towards tuition.
