Financial Aid Information

❖ Parish Scholarship for Grades K-8 (\$2,225)

Applying for this scholarship indicates the parent(s)/guardian is registered as a member of St. Charles Parish and is active in the parish and school community activities- including attendance at weekend Masses and Holy Days of Obligation, various parish activities, and sharing of their time, talent, and treasure. In order to apply for this scholarship you must pick up a St. Charles Scholarship Enrollment Form from the St. Charles Welcome Desk after any weekend Mass between February 26-March 19 2023.

Community Member Scholarship for Grades K-8 (\$350)

By applying for this scholarship parent(s)/guardians are indicating their family is not registered as members of St. Charles Parish, but are active in the life of the school community, including attending and assisting at school events and activities and complete participation in the school fundraiser.

Sibling Scholarship (\$400 per additional student)

Applying for this scholarship indicates that the parent(s)/guardian is registered as a member of St. Charles Parish and are requesting discount for each additional sibling concurrently enrolled at St. Charles in grades K-8. This scholarship does not include preschool or prekindergarten students.

Financial Aid Awards

Families who are registered active parishioners at St. Charles Parish and are in financial need for students in grades K-8 may also be eligible for financial assistance from St. Charles Church. The family must complete FACTS grant and aid application. *The application deadline is April 1, 2021*. The family must reapply each year.
