- Every student will receive a planner at the beginning of the year and is required to bring the planner to each class.
- Planners will be used for the students to write down their assignments, and for teachers to track behavior.
- Students who acquire three behavior notes in their planner during a school day will be issued a lunch detention. Behavior notes could include but are not limited to being tardy, not bringing materials to class, disrupting class, etc.
- Students who have three late or missing assignments in one week will receive a lunch detention.
- Students may also earn a lunch detention for major offenses such as foul language or being sent to administration.
- After three lunch detentions a student will be issued an after school detention.

PBIS

We will have a PBIS celebration at the end of every quarter to promote positive behavior. Below is a list of criteria for each quarters' PBIS celebrations and what the cel.

- 1st Quarter- Students can have a maximum of 4 lunch detentions and 2 unexcused absences
- 2nd Quarter- Students can have a maximum of 3 lunch detentions and 2 unexcused absences
- 3rd Quarter- Students can have a maximum of 2 lunch detentions and 2 unexcused absences
- 4th Quarter- Students can have a maximum of 1 lunch detention and 2 unexcused absences
