RCM Architects have provided a preliminary drawing for replacement of the home side bleachers at the football stadium. This project calls for 1,975 seats with a handicapped ramp on the west end of the bleachers with 2 additional exits in the center of the bleachers and one on the east end of the bleachers. Opening day for the 2008-2009 school year will begin on Monday with breakfast followed by the staff in-service day.
