Maintenance/Transportation reported that the new propane bus has been delivered to the school. Athletic Director gave an oral report and shared the results of two relay teams for girls track at state. The 4x200 placed 5th and the 4x400 placed 11th. The soccer project/lighting project is moving forward. They are getting quotes. It will be a 2-phase project with the lights first and then building. They are still working on project financing. All outside donations will fund this total project. Mr. Hite thanked the Board for the last six years. Board member Mr. Salisbury expressed concern on financing project without having money all up front. The Board thanked Ryan for his service for the last three years as AD. The Superintendent spoke regarding the Strategic Planning Committees. The Superintendent commented that all the strategic committees have submitted their final proposals, except for finance which doesn't meet until June 29. He will compile these and present to the Board over the summer, and will send out for public input.
