

EXITING THE GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM

An exit from the program may be parent, student or teacher initiated. However, a student initiated exit must be supported by the parent.

Parent/Student Initiated: parent need only sign an exit form for the student's permanent file.

GT Coordinator Initiated: If information obtained through a student's annual review of placement reveals that participation in the gifted program is no longer in the best interest of the student, exit procedures will be followed by the district. District exit procedures include a conference with the student and parent. Information obtained during the student's evaluation is presented and an action plan for improvement is created. This action plan includes a deadline, at which the student's progress in the action plan will be re-evaluated by the placement committee. No changes in student services will be made without review and approval by the placement committee. Parents are made aware of placement committee decisions via letter or conference if requested.
