HIGH SCHOOL 12th ANNUAL OPENING KNIGHT

As a way to continue promoting positive interaction and communication between parents, students, and school staff, we will be hosting our 12th Annual Opening Knight, which will be held on Wednesday, August 17, 2011, beginning at 6:30 P.M. Parents and students are asked to enter the school through the front doors closest to the high school offices. The schedule provided below has been developed in an attempt to increase the efficiency of the evening and also to allow you and your parents the opportunity to meet with teachers before the start of classes. During Opening Knight, students will have fall pictures taken (students must wear a school appropriate shirt/blouse), pay school fees for the year, and pick up their schedules. Parents are invited to attend a meeting to meet with the principal and to review important school procedures and policy changes for this year. PARENTS: IMPORTANT SCHOOL BUS SAFETYALERT HELP US PROTECT YOUR CHILDREN AS THEY TRAVEL TO AND FROM SCHOOL

Certain types of children's clothing can create a hazard as your child gets off the school bus. Especially dangerous are:

- Long, dangling jacket or sweatshirt drawstrings
- · Long backpack straps
- · Long scarves or other loose clothing

Such clothing can be caught in the bus handrail, door, or other equipment as the child gets off the bus.

In recent years, a number of children across the U.S. have had their clothing caught as they exited the bus.

Several of these children were dragged by the bus and then killed when the bus ran over them

Please take the time to check your children's clothing to make sure it is safe.

Also, please talk with your child about the following safety rules.

- Stay away from the Danger Zones around the bus.
- Don't try to pick up something dropped near the bus the bus driver might not see you.
- Remember that other motorists don't always stop for a stopped school bus - use extreme caution whenever getting on or off the bus.

Release of Student Names to the Military

We are now REQUIRED by law to release the names and addresses of all students in grades 10-12 to any military branch that requests them. We must do this unless you contact the high school office **in writing** by Friday, September 16, 2011, that you do NOT want your child's name given out. Without your letter stating that you do not want your child's name released, we MUST give all names and addresses out.

SCHOOL BUS PROCEDURES

Parents, please review the following procedures with your children. It is important that they know in detail what is expected of them when they ride a school bus.

School bus transportation should be regarded as a privilege, which will be kept by students only as long as they behave responsibly. All bus students must abide by the following rules at all times if they wish to maintain the privilege of riding on the bus:

- · The bus driver is the adult authority on the bus. He/she is in charge.
- Silence must be maintained while a bus is crossing railroad tracks.
- Be courteous to others. Cursing, teasing, etc. cannot be tolerated.
- · No eating or drinking on the bus.
- Please help keep the bus clean. Don't throw paper or other objects.
- You must stay in your seat at all times.
- Do not extend anything outside a school bus window.
- · No smoking. Do not bring matches on a school bus.
- Please do not mark on or damage seats.
- No fighting.
- This is not an all-inclusive list of inappropriate behaviors. If students use good common sense, they will not have worry about being

disciplined.

School bus drivers must use appropriate disciplinary measures to maintain order and safety on the buses. However, when student misbehavior is so inappropriate, as determined by the driver, that it is a threat to order and safety, a formal set of discipline procedures will be followed.

FIRSTOFFENSE

A written report will be submitted to the appropriate school principal. A copy will be placed in the student's file. A copy may also be mailed to the parent. The principal may also hold a conference with the student and parent.

SECONDOFFENSE

The student's seat may be reassigned by the driver. A telephone contact with the parent will be made by the driver and/or principal. Documentation of the incident will be placed in the student's file. Bus riding privileges could be stopped for a period of time, and other disciplinary measures including detenrion, suspension, and/or expulsion could be used. **THIRD OFFENSE,ETC.**

Bus riding privileges will be stopped for a period of time determined by the principal. Other serious disciplinary actions could also be taken.

News From the Superintendent

Another summer break is winding down and the classrooms will soon be filled with excited students and rejuvenated staff. The first day of school for students will be Wednesday, August 24. No changes have been made to the regular school day. Preliminary bus routes along with drop off and pick up times are available on the district's web site.

Several projects have been completed this summer including improvements to some sidewalk areas, cleaning and repairs to the HVAC system, changes to the old primary entrance of the elementary school, room repairs due to water damage, repairs to the storm sewer in the front parking lot, a complete sanding and refinishing of the varsity gym floor, a wireless access system has been installed in the High School/Middle School building, and general cleaning and waxing of hallways and classrooms. The refinished gym floor makes it look like a brand new floor. The new graphics and lighter color of the floor have changed the appearance drastically. We have used a new finish on this floor. The previous method of finishing the gym floor each summer caused a build-up of material making the floor darken over time. This new finish is designed to keep the floor lighter and brighter. Unfortunately, cleaning and minor repairs to this finish are harder to accomplish. Stricter regulations concerning use and access to this floor will be in effect. The new wireless system will provide for greater, more reliable computer access for our students. This was necessitated in response to our 1 to 1 computer initiative which will be in effect in grades 6 through 10 for the upcoming school year.

While as usual, there has been little turnover in staff at Van Buren, new hires have been completed and quality individuals have been hired. A complete review of new staff will be included in the next newsletter. Fall sports and music activities have started and the hallways, fields, and gyms are full of staff and students. There are still projects that are in progress and in need of completion such as repairs to curbing and exterior lighting. All in all, we are anxious and ready for the start of the new school year and the continued mission of striving for excellence in all areas of the Van Buren Schools, a tradition that we all, staff, students and community, take great pride in and expect.

Parent Notification by District:

If a district receives Title I funds, notification must be sent to parents informing them of the right to request information on the qualifications of their child's teacher. The district must provide (if requested) the following:

- Whether the teacher has met the certification requirements of the state.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher in the field or discipline of his or her certificate or degree.
- Whether or not the child is provided service by a paraprofessional and, if so, his or her qualifications.

All Sports Passes & Season Tickets for 2011-2012

All BVC JV/Varsity tickets prices are \$6 for adults and \$4 for students. Middle School prices remain the same at \$3 Adult and \$2 Student. Van Buren School will once again be offering an All Sports Pass which will entitle the pass holder into every regular home sporting event, (this now includes the Van Buren Wrestling Invitational and all track invitationals). These passes are non-transferable. The family members, upon purchasing the passes, will have their names put on a pass. Passes must be present to enter the event. It does not matter how many members are in the family.

- 1. FAMILY PASS \$250. This plan includes general admission for the parents and all immediate family members in grades 1-12. It includes all home athletic events, junior high through varsity.
- STUDENT ALL SPORTS PASS \$75. General admission for any student, grades 1-12 to all home athletic contests, junior high through varsity.
- ADULT ALL SPORTS PASS \$125. General admission for one adult to all home athletic contests, junior high through varsity
- SEASON FOOTBALL PASS \$24/ADULT, \$16/STUDENT. General admission to all six home varsity football
- SEASON BOYS BASKETBALL PASS \$60/ADULT, \$40/STUDENT. General admission for all home boys' varsity basketball games.
- SEASON GIRLS BASKETBALL PASS \$54/ADULT, \$36/STUDENT. General admission for all home girls' varsity basketball games.

- If you want a Family All Sports Pass and still reserve basketball seats, it will be an additional \$20.00 per seat.
