The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$4,130.31, Escrow checks totaling \$334,382.00, Cooperative checks totaling 6,020.81 and Activity checks totaling \$8,263.43.

The Elementary Principal reported the construction is complete at the elementary building. The beginning of school open house was well attended. The Elementary enrollment is 143. Jon Risor was hired in the kitchen and has started his employment.

Mr. Hamm reported that fall sports practice has started. Due to the small number of girls out for volleyball we will be playing varsity matches only. Activity ticket prices were discussed. The board will address this next summer. Bloomfield will participate in Unified Bowling again this year. Play production practices will start soon. There will be a parents meeting on Sept. 3rd at 7:30 p.m.

The Superintendent stated that there will be a budget workshop and spend down meeting on Aug. 28th at 6:30 p.m. The budget hearing will be held on Sept. 16th, with a regular meeting to follow. This meeting will start at 6:00 p.m. Summer projects are completed. There are new floors and cabinets in the elementary classrooms and kitchen. A new fence and merry go round was installed at the playground this summer. The High School phase 3 projects have been completed. New floors, walls, cabinets and windows have been replaced in the new building area. The carpet on the walls of the old gym have been removed and replaced with sheet rock. This was a Fire Marshall recommendation. The building committee will be meeting to discuss future planning to address Title IX and ADA compliance. The State School Board meeting will be held in Omaha in November.

Committee reports included: American/Civics, Administration Review, Board Policy & Procedures, Negotiations/Staff Relations, Building & Grounds, Transportation, and Budget. Christy Mackeprang will report on American/Civics at the next meeting. The Building & Grounds committee will meet in September.

The Board discussed building renovations and ideas for future Title IX and ADA compliance. Mr. Alexander will be working with Prochaska & Assoc. to develop a sketch and drawings of future remodeling. All staff transporting students will need to take a 2 hr. transportation course. This will be set up soon. The Old gym has been sheet rocked and will be taped and painted soon. The Board would like to be advised as to who is the administrator in charge at all school functions. There are times that Mr. Alexander and Mr. Hamm are not able to attend.

The president adjourned the regular meeting at 7:16 pm.

The next regular special meeting will be the Budget Workshop and spend down August 28th, 6:30 p.m. in Room 203 at the High /school.
